In Freneau travelled to the West Indies, where he studied navigation and wrote, largely about his surroundings. The message is that if one follows the teaching that is provided within the natural world, the mediation of religion is revealed to be The Poems of Philip Freneau lacking in necessity. Freneau's work was chiefly done prior to the Romantic Movement in England, before lyric poetry had received the great impetus and liberation which came with that movement and before poetic form had been released from its classic restraints.
